Our goal is to dedicate the morning hours to schoolwork and online learning and spend the afternoons doing after-school activities listed in the above calendar.

We understand that many of our students have been given class schedules from their teachers, outlining the work they do throughout the day and what times they are expected to attend Zoom meetings or complete other assignments. **Parents, please send us these schedules by this Wednesday, September 2nd.** As we mentioned above, we can adjust our schedule if needed to prioritize the completion of their classwork.

Our Learning Spaces

At both of our Sugarhouse and Liberty Park locations, kindergarteners will have their own classroom, while 1st graders onwards will share a classroom. We think that giving younger students their own space will help them adjust to being in grade school for the first time!

Class sizes will not exceed fifteen students, per COVID-19 safety precautions.

Each student will have a personal and dedicated learning space, divided with poster board, where they can have their laptop and school supplies. We highly encourage that your child decorate this space! Photos, stickers, drawings, and other items to personalize the space will make their school away from school feel like home.

Pick-Up Policy

For those who are attending school in-person, we offer school pick-up services. If you are taking advantage of this service, please let us know if and when there are days your child does **not** need to be picked up from school. We get worried if we go to your child's school and are unaware that you have already picked them up! **If we are not notified of a change in your child's pick up, you will be charged a \$20 fee.** Thank you.

COVID-19 Policies & Precautions

In order to limit the spread of COVID-19, we have implemented several

safety precautions:

- We require that all students are screened for illness when they arrive for school, as well as throughout the day. The screening will include a fever assessment, as well as asking if your child or anyone in your household has any symptoms of COVID-19. We will continue these screenings throughout the day as well.
- We require that all students have at least two masks with them throughout the day. We require that all children wear properly-fitting face masks while in transport and on field trips (cover up those noses!). Though we do not require masks while our students are in our classrooms, we highly encourage it!
- If a child becomes ill with any COVID-19-like symptoms, we will notify you and isolate them while you are on your way to pick them up. Those symptoms include a sore throat, coughing, a runny nose, a fever over 100 degrees, a loss of smell and/or taste, or gastrointestinal issues. Read our COVID-19 policies in full [here](#).
